Dear MVCTC Wolfpack Members and Families:

As we move through this school year our sending districts are required to make instructional delivery model decisions based on county specific data provided from the Department of Health, as well as recommendations from the Governor. In addition to that, each consortium district has elected School Board Directors who vote on issues involving schedules defined in respective Health and Safety Plans. As our consortium encompasses a wide area which spreads across two counties, this letter is being provided to identify how MVCTC will provide instruction in coordination with evolving independent district situations.

Situation	Local District Decision	Attendance at MVCTC
<u>High School Building Data</u> supports recommendation to instruct fully Remote	Local School Board agrees district High School to instruct Fully Remote based on building data.	MVCTC students from that district attend CTC Fully Remote due to safety concern.
<u>County Data</u> supports recommendation instruct fully Remote	Local School Board agrees district High School Remains Hybrid, Blended, or Full In-Person.	MVCTC students from that district attend according to District/MVCTC Hybrid schedule.
<u>High School Building Data</u> supports recommendation remain Hybrid or In-person	Local School Board agrees district High School to instruct Fully Remote solely as a precaution.	MVCTC students from that district attend according to District/MVCTC Hybrid schedule.

Please be advised that other circumstances may necessitate Mon Valley CTC moving to Fully Remote instruction for a period of time this year. Families will receive notification in such a circumstance. Thank you for your continued understanding as we work hard to provide quality Career and Technology Education during this difficult time.
